2023 MISSION PROJECTS

2300 Where Needed Most

Canada

2301 WECLO – Outreach to Immigrants & Refugees, Windsor

\$10,000

Supporting newcomers to Canada through ESL classes, food, clothing and teaching the Word of God.

2302 French Ministry & Mission Support, Quebec **\$12,000**

Assisting Rev. Dr. David Somers in serving our French Ministry in Quebec through travel expenses and material costs.

2303 Street Reach, Regina **\$10,000**

Providing support to Rev. DJ Kim in ministering to troubled youth and young adults through working with police in Regina.

2304 Lay Evangelist Support, Niagara Region **\$22,000**

Supporting Poya Zamani in providing outreach to the Muslim community in Niagara Region.

Central America

2305 Regional Church Workers Training, Central America **\$7,000**

Continuing Theological Education for both pastors and deaconesses.

2306 Music Education Program, Nicaragua **\$5,000**

Teaching children guitar and keyboard while also purchasing Instruments/sheet music.

2307 Community Children's Feeding Programs, Nicaragua **\$20,000**

Providing nutritious meals to children who are living in impoverished conditions alongside sharing Bible stories and songs.

2308 Children's Education Program, Nicaragua **\$10,000**

Providing after school care, help with schoolwork, Christian teachings, & school supplies.

2309 Transportation for Pastors, Nicaragua **\$6,500**

Helping address some of the repairs needed to keep the motorcycles that have been previously purchased road worthy.

2310 Support for Deaconesses & Families, Nicaragua **\$8,000**

Providing funds for continuing education and special training seminars.

2311 Relief Aid for Church Workers in Need, Nicaragua **\$5,000**

Providing financial assistance to our sister Church in Nicaragua to help cover the costs of urgent medical care and treatments for the church workers serving there.

2312 Music Education Program, Costa Rica **\$3,800**

Teaching children guitar and keyboard while also purchasing Instruments/sheet music.

2313 Mission & Ministry of Support, Costa Rica **\$30,000**

Providing annual stipend for Rev. Retana, rent & utilities for mission church in Cartago, transportation expenses, and materials for mission outreach.

Ukraine

2314 Mission & Ministry Support for Rev. Navrotsky, Ukraine **\$14,500**

Providing annual stipend, telephone/internet, and transportation expenses for Rev. Navrotsky.

2315 Ministry & Mission Support, Bashtanka Region **\$4,000**

Supporting two village congregations and two mission stations where church services, Bible studies, and catechism classes are held as frequently as possible during the current strife.

2316 Pastoral Care in Prison Ministry **\$2,500**

Supporting SELCU pastors with transportation, resources, and material expenses.

2317 Mission Outreach & Ministry, Zoria **\$4,000**

Providing outreach in the village of Zoria through Bible studies, meetings with school students and teachers, and distribution of humanitarian aid.

Thailand

2318 Ministry Outreach, Southern Thailand **\$12,000**

Providing a stipend for Rev. Chujit that helps cover his transportation and resource expenses.

Cambodia

2319 Support for Deaconesses **\$10,000**

Assist with the ongoing training and support of the work of the deaconesses serving in Cambodia by covering their travel expenses, material costs, and providing them with a small stipend.
